*NTS 499 SPECIAL STUDIES IN THE NEW TESTAMENT—“Correcting A Crooked Church”...(this course will cover I,II Corinthians and engage topics that the church at Corinth struggled with that are also challenges for the Black church today, such as: divisive personalities and paternalism, the role of women, expectations of the specific tasks of the Pastor, Christian liberty or law, worship—contemporary or reserved as in Western thought, trials of ministering, ecumenical vs. denominational, new wine in old wineskins and more).

**THS499 SPECIAL STUDIES IN THEOLOGY—“The Social Message of Christ”...(this course will engage the notion that the social message of Christ (the Social Gospel) is not foundational for contemporary church development and life, how the church understands and interprets Christ to a post-Christian, post-modern world, how liberation theologies inform the church for stemming economic, gender, ethnic, systemic and physiological oppression, along with understanding the biblical self-understanding of interpreting truth to power and interpreting truth to those who have accepted victimization at their response to culture).
